All prices are subject to change. Baker Aircraft will give thirty days advance notice of any rate changes. Payment is required for all services rendered, including introductory flights. All flight training fees must either be paid upon receipt or deducted from student accounts.

COURSE COMPLETION

The hours specified in each Program or Course fulfill the minimum FAR Part 61 requirements. However, it should be noted that not all students are able to learn to fly well enough to meet the FAA practical test standards in the minimum times listed, and it should not be considered unusual if they are exceeded by as much as 20 hours. Good study habits, personal discipline and aptitude are all necessary ingredients for successful completion of all Programs and Courses.

Rental of the airplanes for the practical test is required. The rental rates vary depending upon airplane used. The practical test normally takes between one and two hours.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If you are late more than 30 minutes or don't show up at all for a scheduled lesson, you will be charged a no-show fee. Baker Aircraft requires 24 hours advance notice to cancel a scheduled lesson or a booking for a solo rental.

CERTIFICATES ISSUED

Upon completion of each individual course or program, you will receive a graduation certificate from Baker Aircraft. Upon successful completion of the FAA practical test you will receive the appropriate FAA certificate or rating. Please note that Baker Aircraft provides placement and career guidance to graduates, but that employment is **not** guaranteed.

REFUND POLICY

You are entitled to a full refund of the unused portion of your flight account balance at any time for any reason. Refunds will normally be issued within 30 days but may be delayed until your check has cleared. Student account balances obtained from education loans will be refunded to the lending institution as required at the completion of training. All book purchases are final and nonrefundable. Money left on account and not used for more than two years is not refundable.

SCHOOL HOURS AND ATTENDANCE

Baker Aircraft is open seven days per week, from 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM in the summer and 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM in the winter. After-hours lessons and night flights can be scheduled by arrangement with your instructor. We are closed on major holidays; however training/rentals can be arranged on a case by case basis. Program and Course starting dates will be arranged on a date convenient to the student and the school after receipt of this enrollment agreement.

STUDENT APPEARANCE

For safety reasons, you are not permitted to wear open-toed shoes. Since flight instruction takes place within the confines of a small aircraft, you should maintain acceptable standards of personal hygiene.

DISENROLLMENT POLICY

If you violate any of Baker Aircraft's rules and regulations, you will be placed on probation for a period of 4 weeks. If you continue to violate Baker Aircraft's rules and regulations, you will be disenrolled from the school.

PROGRAM CHANGES

Baker Aircraft reserves the right to change or modify the contents of any of the individual courses, and to change or modify equipment, staff and/or materials used. In some cases, changes may be mandated by FAA regulations. In other cases, changes or modification may be necessary to improve teaching methods or to keep pace with technological advances.

PILOT FINANCE, INC. – Many flight schools that provide part-time training offer financing through Pilot Finance, Inc., a specialized flight training finance company. Pilot Finance stretches the cost of flight training over repayment periods of up to seven years, depending upon the training schedule chosen by the student. A typical three lesson per week schedule can be financed for up to four years at interest rates usually ore than traditional student loans, but much less, normally, than credit card rates.

Since Pilot Finance does not pre-quality flight schools, nearly any school can offer financing at no cost to the school itself. Pilot Finance requires its flight schools to keep financed training dollars in escrow. The flight school withdraws funds from escrow only after services have been delivered – such as when a flight lesson is completed. Because of this feature, students have the right to terminate their training program at any time for any reason while being guaranteed access to the funds that have not been used. This provides a significant degree of financial protection, and eliminates much of the risk inherent should a student need to drop out or be unsatisfied.

ROTORCRAFT PRIVATE PILOT ADD ON MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- (c) For a helicopter rating. Except as provided in paragraph (k) of this section, a person who applies for a private pilot certificate with rotorcraft category and helicopter class rating must log at least 40 hours of flight time that includes at least 20 hours of flight training from an authorized instructor and 10 hours of solo flight training in the areas of operation listed in Sec. 61.107(b)(3) of this part, and the training must include at least--
- (1) 3 hours of cross-country flight training in a helicopter;
 - (2) Except as provided in Sec. 61.110 of this part, 3 hours of night flight training in a helicopter that includes--
 - (i) One cross-country flight of over 50 nautical miles total distance; and
 - (ii) 10 takeoffs and 10 landings to a full stop (with each landing involving a flight in the traffic pattern) at an airport.
 - (3) 3 hours of flight training in preparation for the practical test in a helicopter, which must have been performed within 60 days preceding the date of the test; and
 - (4) 10 hours of solo flight time in a helicopter, consisting of at least--
 - (i) 3 hours cross-country time;
 - (ii) One solo cross-country flight of at least 75 nautical miles total distance, with landings at a minimum of three points, and one segment of the flight being a straight-line distance of at least 25 nautical miles between the takeoff and landing locations; and
 - (iii) Three takeoffs and three landings to a full stop (with each landing involving a flight in the traffic pattern) at an airport with an operating control tower.

Your total required hours in a helicopter is a minimum of 20 hours of dual and 10 hours solo if you already have your private pilot license in an airplane.

Some individuals realistically get their add on license anywhere from 30 hours to 80 hours depending on the persons ability.
